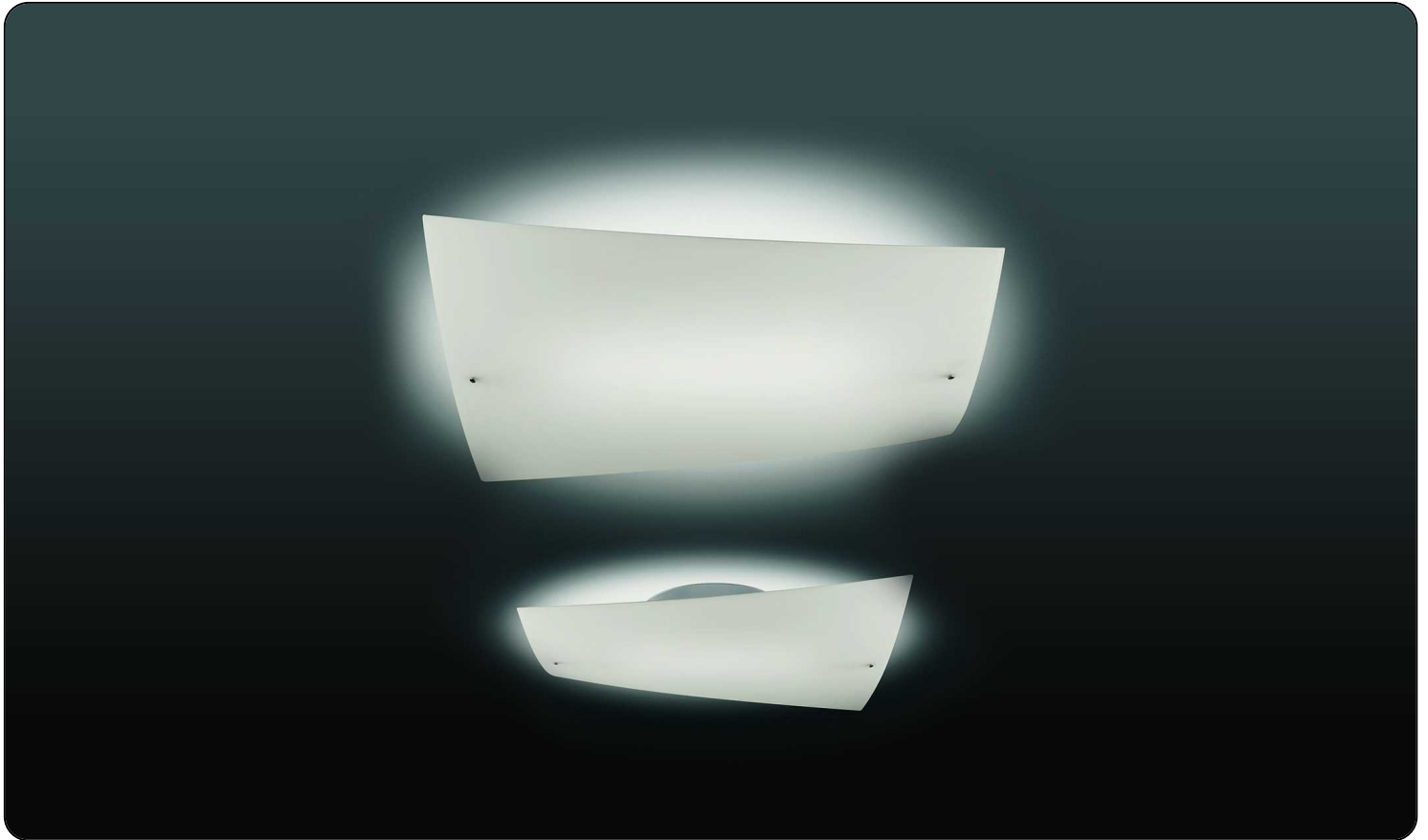

Designed by the founders of Foscarini in the first years of the company's life, Folio pays homage to the simplicity of the small gestures that make a lighting design decorative. This lamp evokes a sheet of paper being stretched. Two corners bend slightly towards the wall or the ceiling with a movement just hinted at but enough to give volume to the twodimensional shape of a sheet of paper. Two small screws hook the blown glass diffuser to the metal support and these two points become a delicate decorative element. Folio's light source is housed inside the metal support and

diffuses a warm, intense light through its satin-finished screen.

Description

Wall or ceiling lamp with reflected and diffused light. Hand-blown cased glass diffuser, hot bent and subject externally to immersion in acid. Mounting plate, housing the lighting technology part, made of aluminium colour epoxy powder coated die cast zamak.

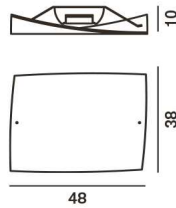

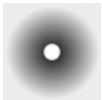

They both began their relationship with Foscarini as designers, starting out the present lamp collection. After some time they took up the management, becoming the authors of it's history.

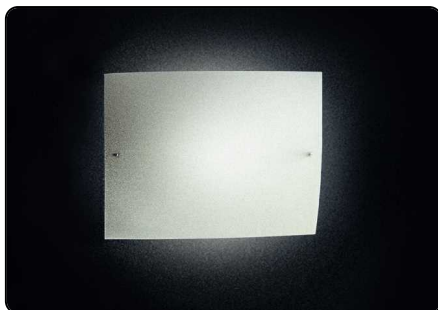
