## WCM Wired module button legend options

### WCM

A WCM module is fully configurable during programming. Whilst this gives complete control to the programmer, many situations will want to follow standard programming formats for consistency and clarity.

To facilitate the use of button layouts common with WCM modules, button layouts are available as separate order items and can be easily changed on WCM modules.

Separate order button part codes are given opposite.
